

**The Barnacle**: An historic treasure in Coconut Grove, that is vulnerable to fire. This grant will go towards installation of a sprinkler system for the Barnacle house as well as the boat house.



**Vizcaya:** One of the third projects for the newly formed Villagers in the 1960's. We are back again as we celebrate 50 years of saving places, this time to help support the conservation treatment of a pair of ornate antique metal light fixtures that decorate the east facade of the Main House. The fixtures are in need of restoration from corrosion and weather-related damage.

Biscayne Park Foundation- Log Cabin: This historic log cabin "Village Hall" is being returned to its original intent as a community and government meeting hall. Villager funds will be used to restore the floor, part of which is the original Dade County pine. The Works Progress Administration (WPA) built this log cabin during the depression in 1933 for the Village of Biscayne Park.





**Barry University:** The Shepard and Ruth K. Broad Center for the Performing Arts is a mid-century proscenium theater constructed in 1955 which celebrated its 75th anniversary in 2015. The grant will be used to help repair the original seats. Efforts will be made to help students recognize and appreciate the importance of historic preservation.

Redland Farm Life School: This school, built in 1916, was badly damaged in Hurricane Andrew and has been vacant since. The School Board wanted to tear it down, but the residents of the area fought back and helped raised funds to restore it after Miami Dade County leased it to the South Florida Pioneer Museum. The outside has been finished but the inside is waiting to be finished. Plans include using it as a center for farm life in the area. It will have a teaching kitchen, a commercial kitchen for local businesses to rent, and a museum space. The Villagers grant will be used to help finance a mobile teaching unit and outreach to help raise funds to complete the interior. It will also include a portable interpretive unit that will go into the museum.
