Miami Villagers support the Miracle Theatre

Miami Villagers, a group dedicated to the preservation and restoration of historic sites, recently presented a check for \$7,867 to the Actors' Playhouse at the Miracle Theatre. The funds were used to replace carpet in the lobby and theater aisles and were designed to complement the theater's historic terrazzo floors.

This is one of many projects the organization has supported at the theater throughout the years including electrical system updates, wood panel replacement and terrazzo floor restoration. The Miracle Theatre opened as a movie theater in 1948. In 1994, it was acquired by the city and was declared a historic landmark in 1995. It is an impressive Art Moderne style building on Miracle Mile and serves as the home of the Actors' Playhouse. Currently the city is conducting a re-roofing project.
